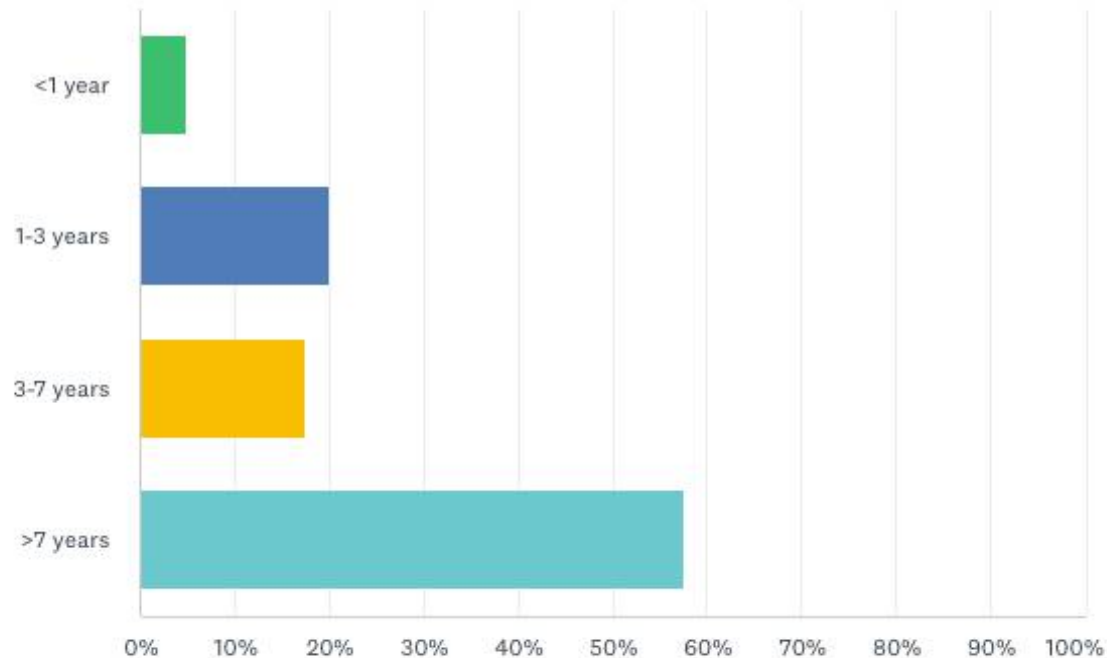

To start, we're interested in understanding the makeup of the length of residence in our neighborhood. How long have you lived in River Park?

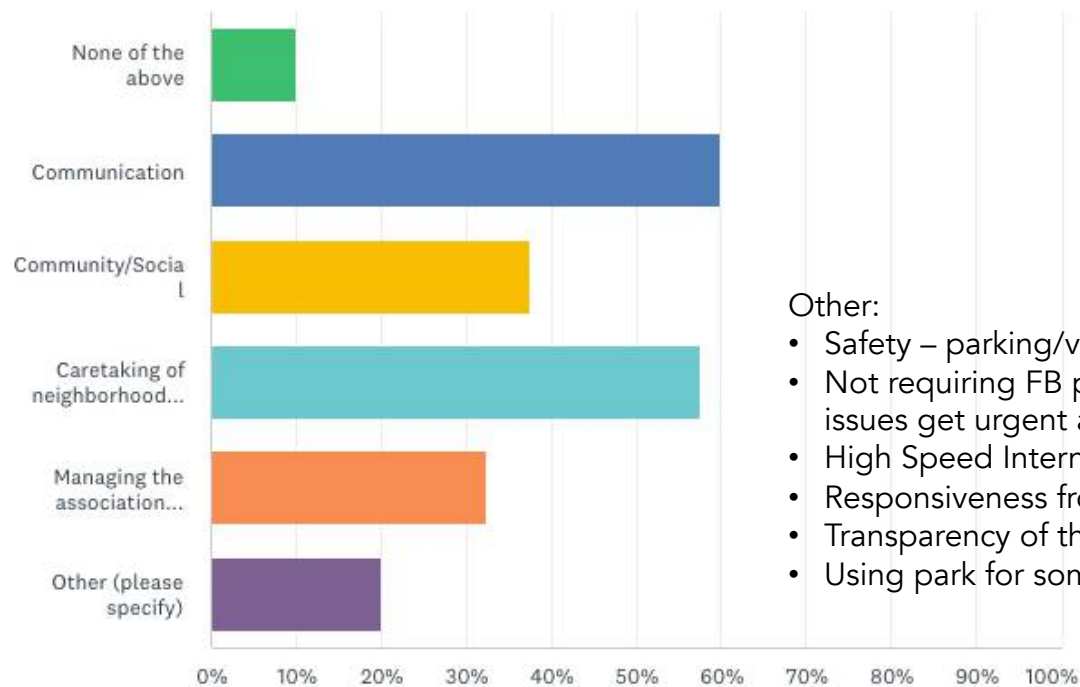

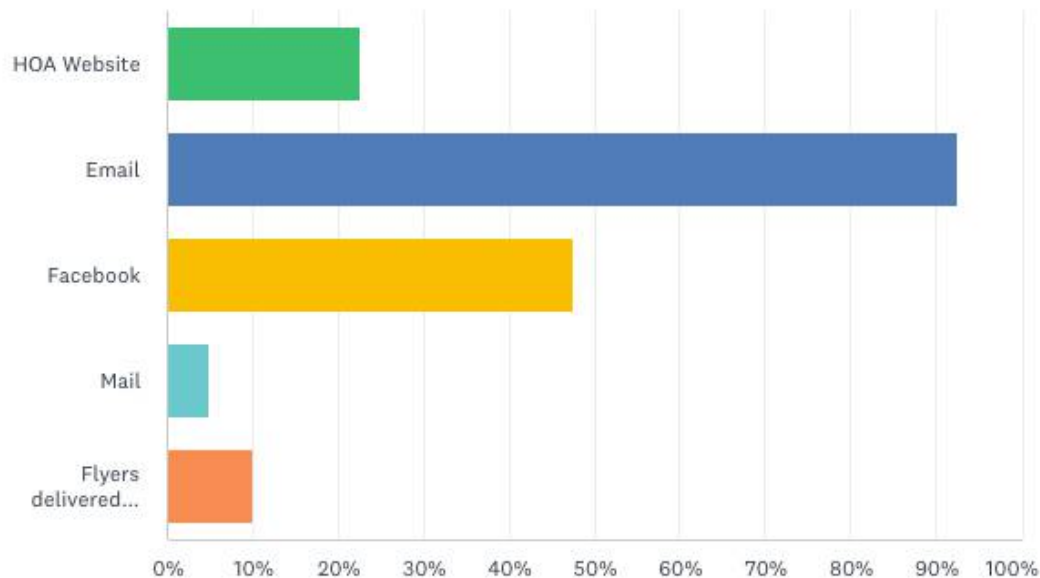
Other:

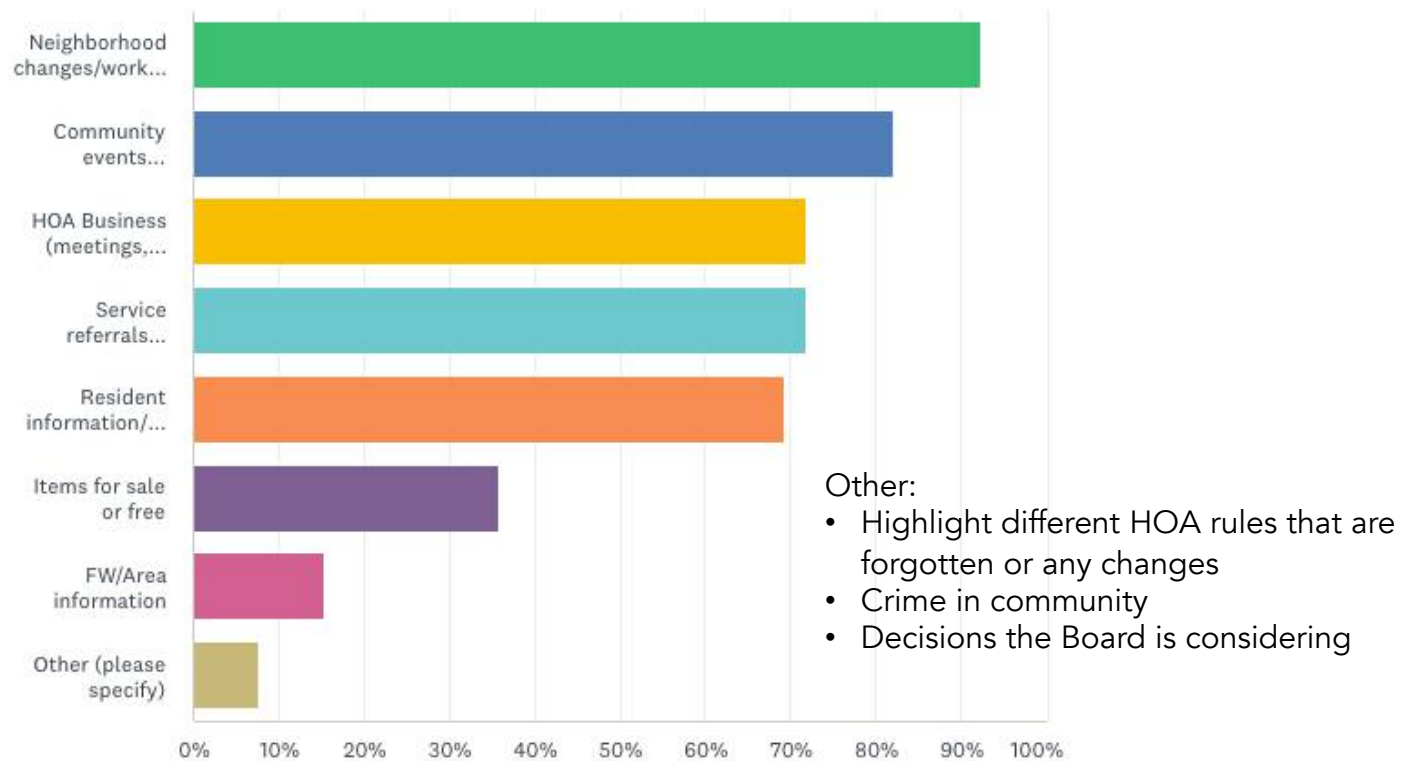

We would like to design a newsletter to deliver regular and consistent information to our residents and want to focus on what matters most to you. What information would you be interested in hearing about? (Check all that apply)

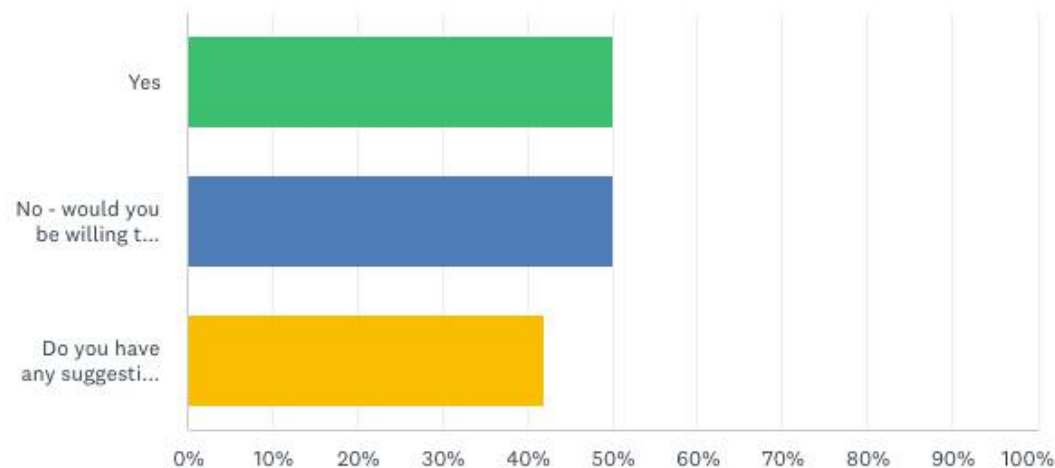

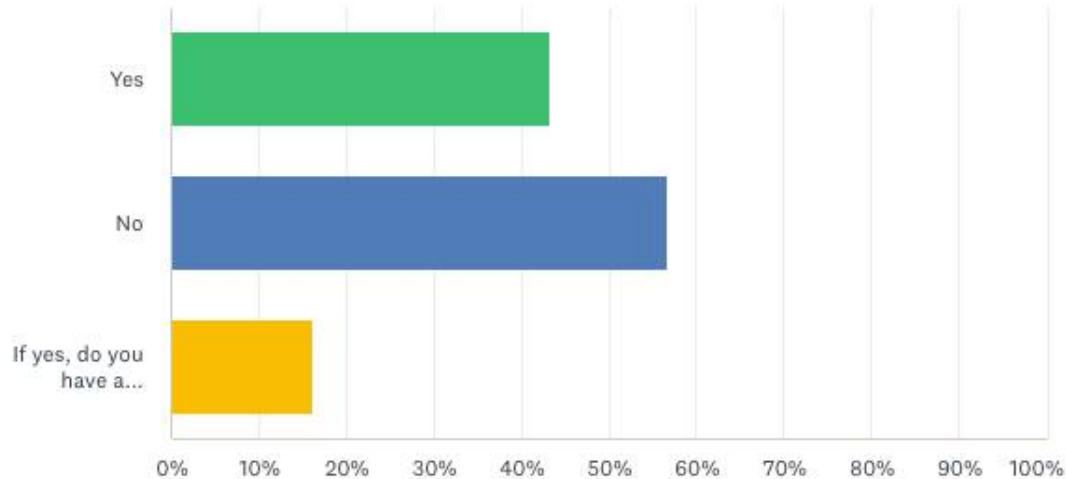
Suggestions for Meetings:

- Provide agenda and minutes so less formal talking and more open discussion (x4)
- Timing conflicts (x3)
- Zoom only (x2)
- Solicit input from residents in advance for added agenda items
- More often (quarterly) and more social and collegial

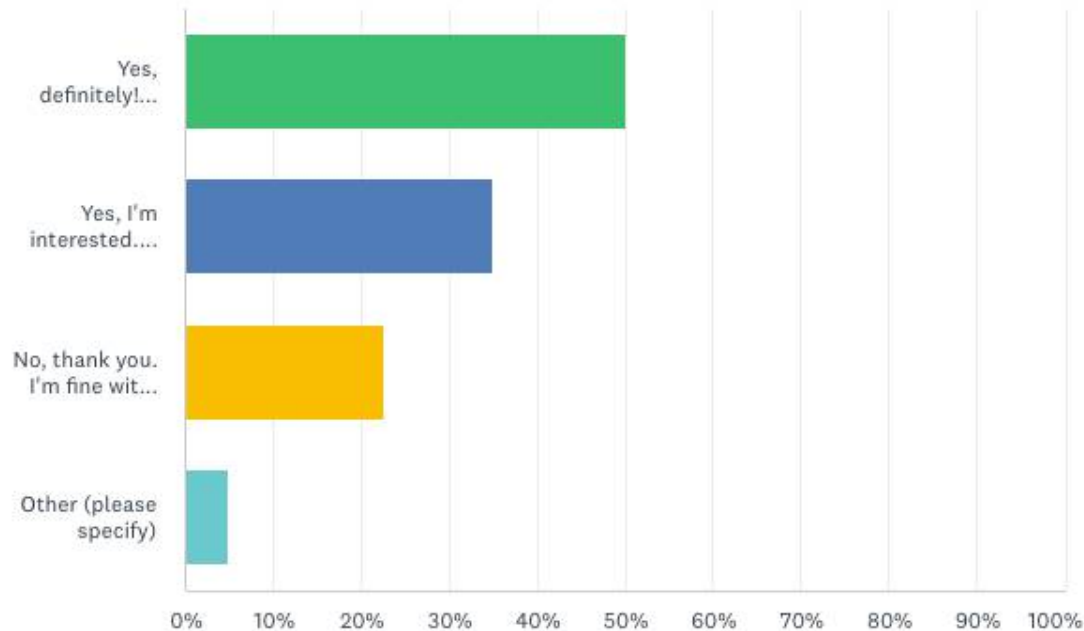
